Local musician to play at Main Pub

Manchester native and graduate of Manchester High School Dan Prindle will return to his hometown on Friday, Nov. 22, for a headlining show at the Main Pub. After launching a successful musical career with New England jam-band juggernaut Rane, Prindle, a multi-instrumentalist and vocalist, has recently penned and recorded his first solo collection of songs. The album, "Where You Land," is a contemplative but accessible exploration of pop-rock song forms. Prindle's varied influences can be heard throughout, as the album's moods range from the experimental ambience of Radiohead to the jazz-inflected funk of Steely Dan to the straightforward pop-rock of Billy Joel.

Prindle is an experienced performer and recording artist, having shared the stage and the studio with a diverse collection of commercially and critically successful artists, including The Allman Brothers Band, The Jerry Garcia Band and Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers. He is also a successful songwriter and composer.

The new album will be available for the first time at the show. Tickets for this 21-and-over show are \$10 and are available at the door. Prindle and his
